**Re: Update on the current situation of CMI in times of the Covid-19 pandemia**

In relation to the world Covid-19 pandemia I would like to inform you that CMI is now in full operation, no employee has yet been tested positive on the virus. All our premises are fully equipped with disinfectants, available also to our customers when delivering to CMI. CMI employees would consequentially use respirators/face masks, those providing services on spot are equipped with additional protective means (glasses, gloves). Taking into account a hopeful upswing in economic activities in later stages of this year the top management has decided, in accordance with our labour code, to declare an all-institute mandatory holidays in the time period of 6.4 – 17.4.2020 **with the exception of all the employees needed to take care of a basic operation of our facilities and smooth delivery of all the contracted metrological services as required.** Namely, some customers would use this period of outages in their manufacturing or other operations to get their measuring instruments calibrated. Those services would go uninterrupted even during the all-institute holidays inclusive e.g. conformity assessment services under the European harmonized legislation (directives NAWID, MID and RED), in auditing (module D) using electronic means of communication.
